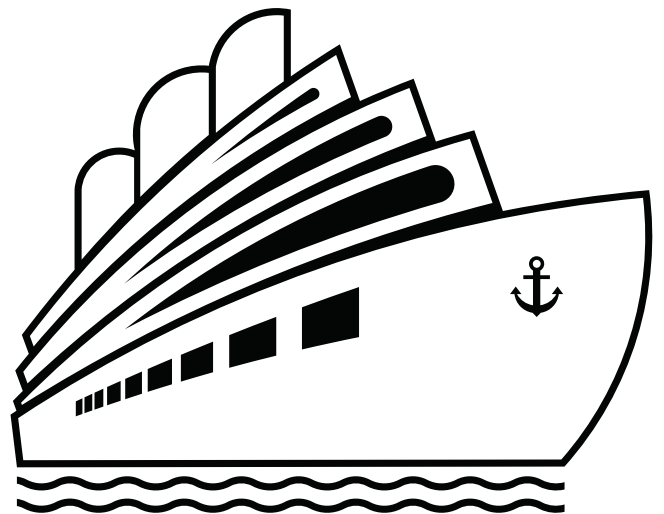

- 2) Confirm NLC STAR Events Schedules: In the FCCLA Portal under Meetings & Events > Confirm STAR Competition**

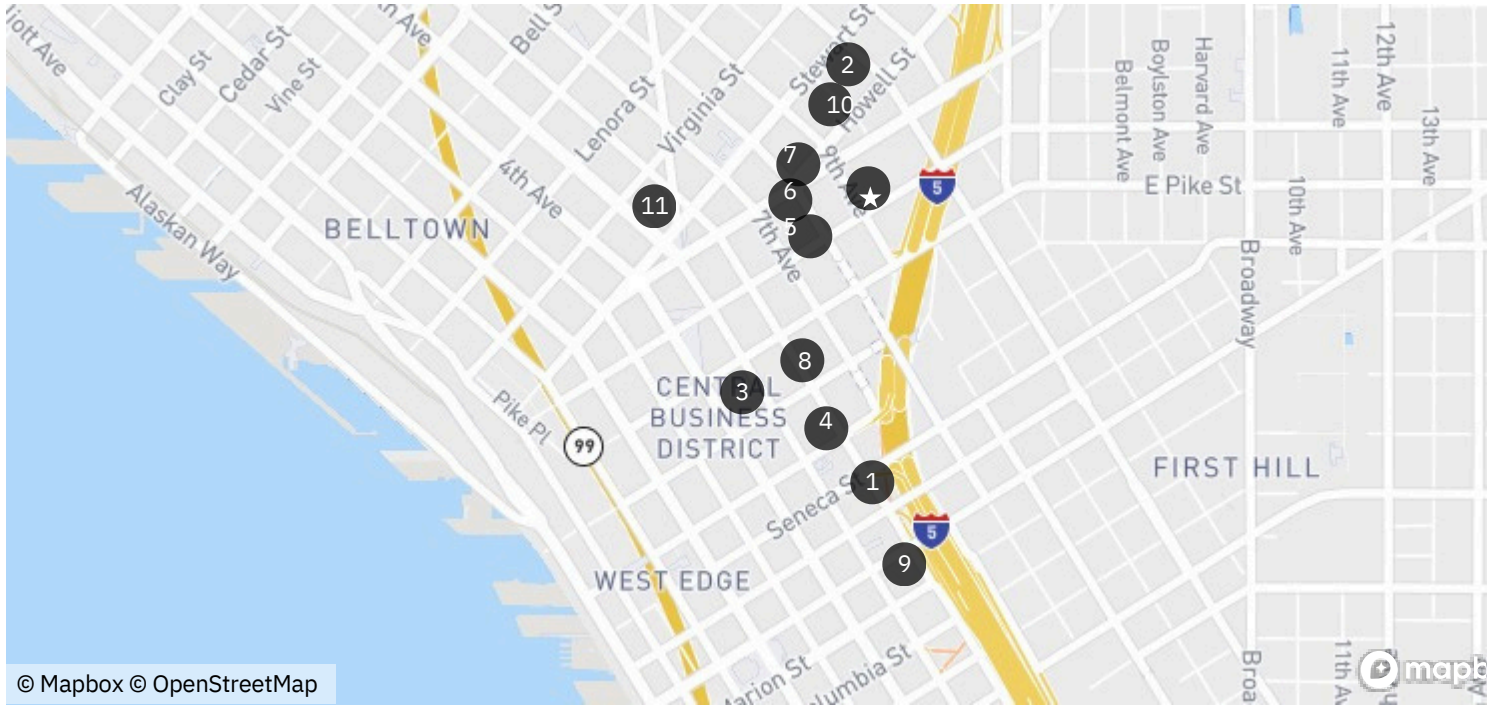
You may add orders for special events and other items to your registration in the portal. Be sure to complete the required forms for both student members and adults! They will be required at registration pick-up.

SEATTLE TRAVEL TIPS



Transportation Options in Seattle:

Seattle Public Transportation--look into this for inexpensive transportation options from the airport and getting around downtown

Several of the local eateries and stadiums offer only **cashless transactions**--plan accordingly!

Many retailers will NOT offer bags for your purchases--consider bringing your own bags or a backpack that you can store your purchases in.



Walking tips for downtown Seattle:

Look for the QR code posters in the hotel lobby--scanning these will give you the recommended walking route to the Convention Center

Consider using 1st Avenue rather than routes including 2nd, 3rd, 4th, Pike, or Pine

Always stay in groups, and be sure you have an adviser or chaperone with you when leaving the hotel or Convention Center!



Downtown Seattle has a **Community Safety and Hospitality Team**. Their job is to help visitors with directions and safety. Look for the blue and yellow jackets and ask for assistance if you need it!
