

# **State FCCLA Parking Information**

**March 19–20, 2026**

To ensure a safe and efficient unloading and loading of students, please read the following instructions. For questions, please contact Parking and Transportation Services at 406-994-1723.

1. Please follow instructions from Parking Officers
2. **Please keep curbside parking for 5-7 minutes or less to accommodate other schools.**
3. **NO VEHICLES LEFT UNATTENDED IN UNLOADING OR LOADING AREAS**

## **UNLOADING**

1. Unloading will occur along south 7<sup>th</sup> and in the SUB oval.
2. All buses must approach the Unloading area from Kagy on to south 7<sup>th</sup> and exit via Grant Street to S. Willson.
3. Any bus that approaches off Grant St. will be turned back and told to approach from South 7<sup>th</sup>.
4. When space is available in the SUB Oval a Parking Officer will direct you to the oval.
5. Once your vehicle is unloaded, please proceed to your designated parking area.
  - a. **Busses and oversized vehicles** – South end of Bobcat Lot 25 on the east side of Bobcat Stadium. (See attached map)
  - b. **Personal or smaller vehicles** – Parking Garage on 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> floors. If you received a coupon code, please use it at the kiosk. If you did not receive a coupon code, you will need to pay for parking at the kiosk or through Passport Parking App. **Remember your license plate number as this is required to complete the transaction.**
6. **Busses and oversized vehicles** – Please proceed to the second entrance into Bobcat Lot 25 on the east side of Bobcat stadium where a parking officer will be there to assist.

## **LOADING**

1. **Personal and smaller vehicles** – All loading will occur in the Parking Garage.
2. **Buses and oversized vehicles** – All loading will occur in Bobcat Lot 25, just east of the Bobcat Stadium. (**See attached map**)
3. If closer loading assistance is needed due to the students' project, loading on South 7<sup>th</sup> Ave. is available but make sure all students are ready before having the bus or vehicle pull up along South 7<sup>th</sup> Ave.
