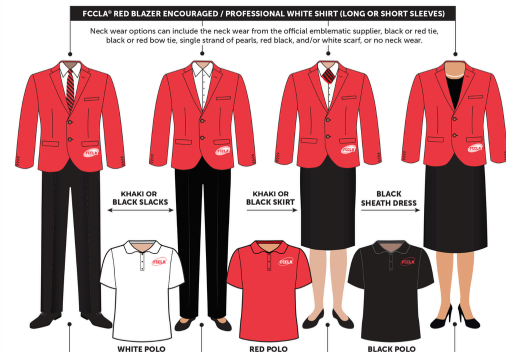


CONFERENCE POLICIES
