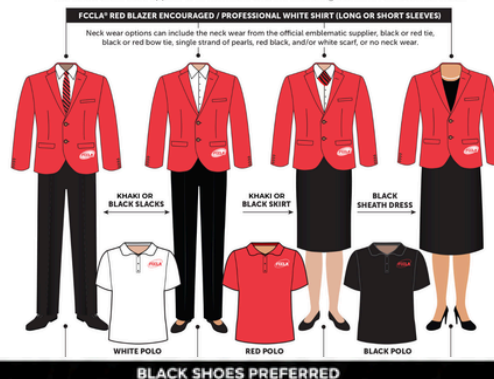


CONFERENCE POLICIES
