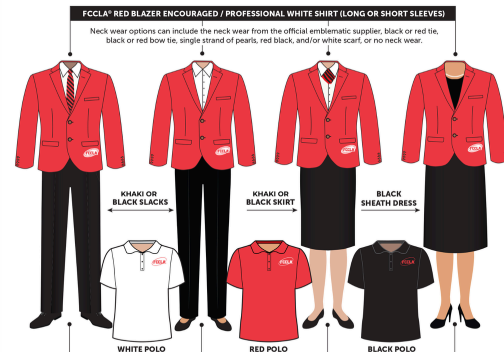


## CONFERENCE POLICIES
