Montana FCCLA's State Outreach Project empowers chapters and members to engage in career exploration, build employability skills, and take action in their schools and communities.



Chapters are encouraged to participate individually or as a chapter (or both!) to earn incentives and recognition as Montana FCCLA chapters prepare members for career success. The 2026 State Outreach Project includes many participation options, including:



MEMBER AND ADVISER TRAINING (OUTREACH PROJECT)

- All advisers attending the 2026 Montana FCCLA Fall Leadership Rally (September 27-28 in Billings) will receive a complimentary copy of Career Connections, a comprehensive career-readiness curriculum and training for curriculum integration.
- Advisers unable to attend may request a copy of Career Connection by submitting the [form linked here](#) or scanning the QR code and completing the form by **October 1**.
- Each chapter may register up to three student members to participate in the State Outreach Project training at the Rally. Attendees will learn about the project, gain project resources, and plan and implement an outreach project.



PROJECT RESOURCES & SUPPORT

- No matter which participation option(s) you choose, members can increase their career preparation skills. Real world resources are available all across the state to support chapter outreach projects.



CHAPTER MINI-GRANTS AND RECOGNITION

- Chapters can apply for mini-grants to support outreach projects and earn recognition for exemplary projects.
- Mini-grant applications are on our [website](#): priority deadline is November 13; final deadline is December 4
- Final report due March 1
- State-level cash awards: \$500 for 1st place, \$300 for 2nd place, \$200 for 3rd place. See the project guide by Career Connection unit (with implementation guides) on our website.

Building the skills for success



TEAMWORK FESTIVAL

Host games and challenges for elementary students that build teamwork and conflict management skills; important qualities for career success.



CLASSROOM-BASED BUSINESS

Launch a coffee service or entrepreneurship project to build teamwork, leadership, and job skills.



LEADERSHIP STYLES BULLETIN BOARD

Create a bulletin board featuring leadership styles and quotes from faculty and staff about how they lead.

Partner with a local credit union to offer a financial management simulation where students make real-life spending decisions.

Create a bulletin board full of leadership prompts and encourage students to deliver the cards to others who demonstrate leadership.

CAREER CONNECTION PODCASTS

Create a podcast series showcasing what members have learned about career readiness and exploration and share on YouTube.

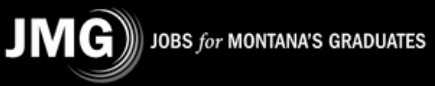
